

# Louis Comfort Tiffany's Laurelton Hall Cell Phone Audio Tour

The Morse Museum is pleased to be able to provide you with an audio tour of our Laurelton Hall exhibition that is accessible via cell phone.

The tour begins in the Laurelton Hall Introduction Gallery and ends in the Tiffany Chapel. It includes 27 stops at both objects and wall panels and lasts about 45 minutes. Stops are designated by three-digit numbers and cell phone icons.



**TO TAKE THE TOUR**, dial (407) 618-0081. At each stop, follow the prompts and enter the number to listen.

**TO HOLD OR PAUSE THE TOUR**, press ## (the pound sign twice) on the phone's keypad.

**AT ANY POINT**, visitors may end the call and redial the tour number later.

**PLEASE DO NOT USE THE SPEAKERPHONE FUNCTION.**  
Hold the phone to your ear or use earbuds (available for purchase in the Museum Shop).

The tour is free although it will be counted as a wireless call on the user's phone. Charges for minutes or roaming may accrue depending on individual plans. The entire tour may use 10 to 30 percent of a cell phone's battery power depending on the visitor's device. Sound quality as well as reception may vary depending on mobile service providers and phones.

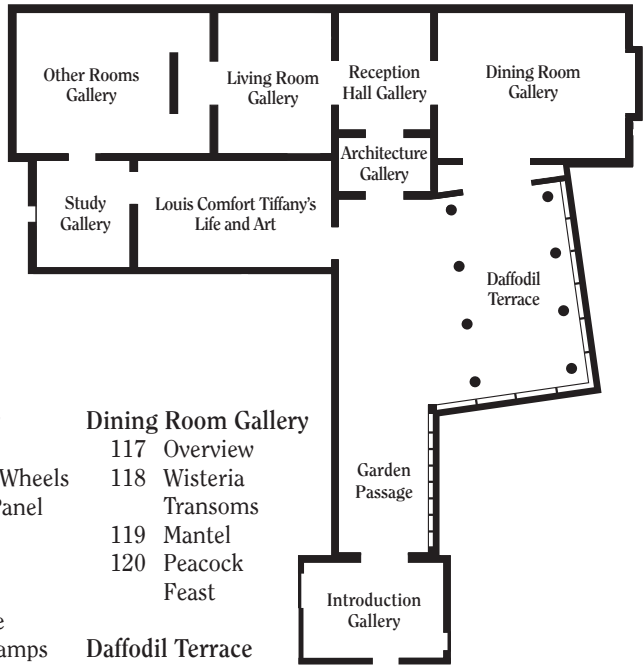
