### **INSTRUCTIONS:**

## **MATERIALS:**

- $8 \frac{1}{2}$ " x 11" white paper
- Printer
- Color and Texture by Number template
- Colored pencils and/or crayons (using both will yield the best texture and color blending results)

# **COLOR AND TEXTURE KEY:**

1 - Color: Light Tan Texture: Smooth

2 - Color: Green Texture: Bubbly

3 - Color: Blue Texture: Bubbly

4 - Color: Blue-Green Texture: Bubbly

5 - Color: Dark Blue Texture: Smooth

6 - Color: Yellow-Green Texture: Bubbly
